Why Giving Matters

I am honored to pen this letter as the new Director of Development at Cobb School. As a parent whose children have been at the school for seven years, I have watched our community thrive and grow, yet I must admit, I often found myself questioning the constant monetary requests, wondering, "why not just increase tuition?" As I assumed this new role, my appreciation of fundraising has evolved significantly.

Non-profit schools like ours rely heavily on fundraising. It forms a crucial part of our revenue, helping us cover costs that tuition alone cannot. Currently, tuition accounts for about 85% of our operating costs, leaving a 15% gap that needs to be filled. This shortfall includes essential elements that enrich our students' experience — from maintaining our beautiful campus to supporting professional development for our dedicated faculty, from funding unique learning opportunities such as field trips to ensuring our classrooms are equipped with Montessori-approved learning materials.

So, why not simply raise tuition? The answer is inclusion. We strive to make our remarkable Montessori education accessible to as many families as possible. Dramatically increasing tuition could place a burden on many families, potentially changing the diverse and inclusive nature of our community that we cherish so much. Understanding this has led me to a newfound appreciation of our Culture of Giving. Each donation, no matter how small, contributes to the betterment of our school and directly impacts our students' educational experience. Your generosity ensures that we can continue to offer an enriching, engaging, and exceptional educational environment.






